During the session participants will be given an overview on assistance to passengers from the legal point of view with analyses of article 18 of Regulation (EC) No 1371/2007 on rail passengers' rights and obligations (PRR), followed by a contribution on the legal implications of COVID-19 on passenger transportation.

Different speakers coming from the railway sector will then present practically, how they provide assistance on board the trains and at the stations, and how they dealt with the after-sales process in times of COVID-19.

Moreover, there will be an overview on the CIT products which are of interest for customer services, including the revised Manual on Data Protection (MDP), amendments to the AIV and to the MIRT and other useful information coming from the CIT.

The highlight of the conference will be the workshops dealing this time specifically with the assistance for continuation of the journey due to missed connections and the offering of accommodation when the passenger has missed the last connection of the day.

Assistance is a permanent challenge for customers services. The conference offers good opportunities for networking, giving participants the possibility to discuss unclarified issues or disputed cases.
